Then we sympathised with the Americans but we were greatful that it was them not us RESIDENT EISENHOWER MADE IT CLEAR has. In centres in many parts of COOKS AS It could nt happen here - but it h Britain mass prejudice has shown itself , for the first time, in all its ugliness. Riots, Beatings, hooliganism. Now its our problem and we must solve it..... 190,000 coloured people live in Britain - less than 1 of 1% of the population and in the main they live happily. A little strange at first, they soon settle into living and working with their new neighbours. Working in harmony and peace Good workers, honest decent people who ve come here because this is the mother country of the Commonwealth. By right it is their second home. Now their faith in us and the Commonwealth has been shaken by violence. Why did it happen? What must we do?....
