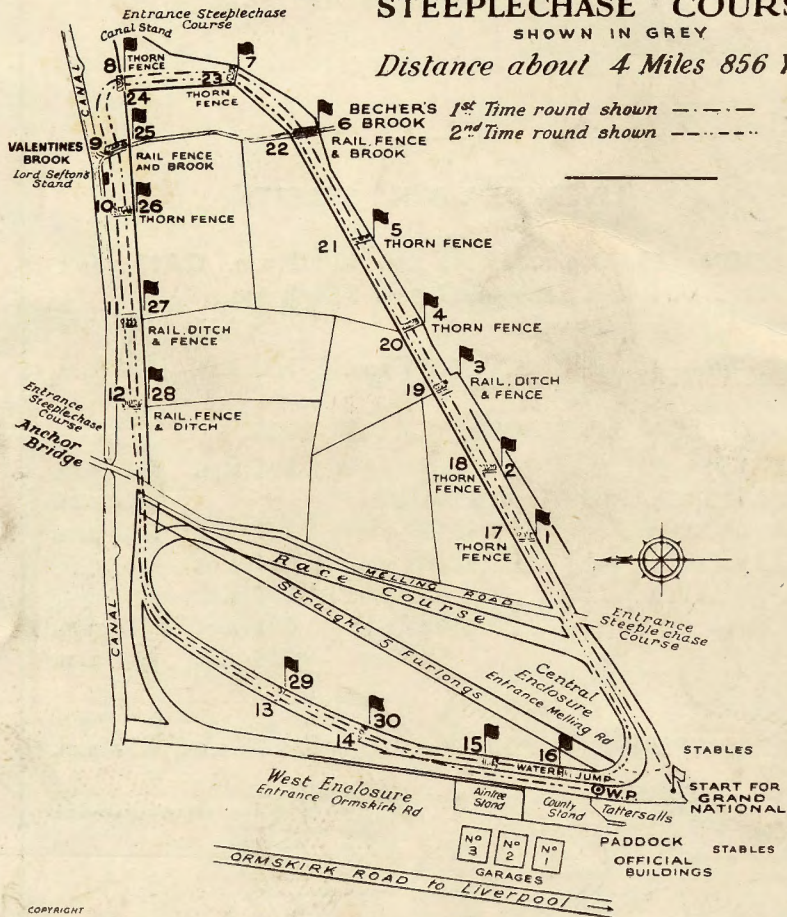

**2-0** The LIVERPOOL HURDLE RACE (Handicap) of 1000 sov. (including a trophy value 100 sov., at the option of the winner), for four yrs old and upwards; the second to receive 200 sov. and the third 100 sov. out of the plate; the highest handicap weight to be not more than 12st 7lb; the winner, after the publication of the weights (March 1st, at noon), of a hurdle race to carry 4lb, of two hurdle races, or of one value 300 sov., 6lb, of two hurdle races value 300 sov. each, or of one value 500 sov., 8lb, or of a hurdle race value 1000 sov., 12lb extra, but horses originally handicapped at 11st 12lb or over to carry half penalties, and no penalty to increase a horse's weight to more than 12st 7lb; entrance 5 sov. each, and 10 sov. extra unless forfeit be declared by Tuesday, March 6th; two miles, one furlong, over nine flights of hurdles. Declaration of forfeit to Messrs. Weatherby and Sons only. 59 entries. Forfeit declared for 19. Closed January 31st, 1956.
