# SIR ROBERT KINDERSLEY'S SPEECH.

Sir Robert Kimdersley, President of the National Savings Committee, presiding at the "Win the War" Luncheon at Grosvenor House today (Wednesday) said.

I would, the why and the wherefore of this lunch.

When the Chancellor made his concession to the book trade regarding the Purchase Tax, he not only conferred a blessing on all those who are book-lovers but also on the vast army who in their various spheres are book-makers.

Our friend, Miss Christina Foyle, with her usual flair, was not long in realising that it would be a gracious act on the part of all authors and others concerned in this vast trade and the professions allied to it to ask the Chancellor to a Lunch as their principal guest and to show him by their presence their appreciation of the concession granted to them.

But Miss Foyle went further. She coupled the Lunch, as you will see if you look at your card of invitation, with the War Savings Campaign, in which the Chancellor is so deeply interested. No doubt she was moved by the knowledge that any campaign that depends on publicity could be enormously assisted by the support of the pens of all you gentlemen here today, and may I add that as President of the National Savings Committee I shall be enormously grateful for any help that you can give us. We need all the help we can get, for our task is a heavy one and grows heavier each day as the cost of the war increases.

On November 21st we shall have been at our job for twelve months. Up to doday the man of modest means has invested in Savings Certificates, Defence Bonds and Post Officeand Trustee Savings Banks over £400 million. In National War Bonds up to Tuesday £250 million has been invested and over £20 million has been subscribed in free of interest loans.

We are asking the country as a whole to strain every nerve to reach a figure of \$475 million in the first category. This calls for an average of £12 millions a week, and weare asking for an average of £20 millions in War Bonds. It requires an effort but it can be done and I am glad to tell you that for the week ending Tuesday fourteen million, six hundred and ten thousand pounds were invested in War Bonds and six hundred and fifty thousand pounds in loans free of interest - or a total of fifteen million, two hundred and sixty thousand pounds - the best week since August 21st.

The whole nation can through these channels give its answer to the brutal and indiscriminate bombings of the enemy. We can show that far from intimidating us the enemy has awoken in us the spirit of sacrifice and self-discipline.

The Chancellor of the Exchequer was the principal guest at a Foyle "Win the War" Luncheon at Grosvenor House today (Wednesday).

Sir Robert Kindersley, President of the National Savings Committee, was in the chair.

#### THE CHANCELLOR'S SPEECH

Sir Kingsley Wood said:

This is a "Win the War" Luncheon. We are fighting for many things - our own liberty and that of others - Right - Justice - Civilisation itself.

certainly we know that writers - all over the world - whatever their creed or colour - who stand for the Dignity of Man and
the free development of the individual must be on our side. It was
not for nothing that the much trumpeted Nazi Revolution began with
a symbolic Burning of the Books It was not for nothing that the
very first refugees from Germany were writers - the harbingers
and pioneers of that melancholy exodus which numbering thousands
upon thousands - only ceased at the outbreak of 'ar because the
Frontiers were no longer open. They were writers of whom any other
Nation would have been proud and whose work may yet seem even to
the German people the only feature in this period of their History
on which they can look back without shame.

Their departure left Germany an intellectual desert - a place where the mere process of putting pen to paper had become a dangerous trade. Wherever Hitler's Shadow has fallen - and it is a shadow that now darkens the greater part of the Continent of Europe - that evil has been extended. Always it is the first act of the Nazi invader to throttle freedom of speech and of thought, to control the spoken and the written word.

It is our glory and our pride that here in this place - this land of ours - the writer can write as and what he wishes and that our Press and Platform are bastions of our liberty and freedom.

We know full well that Victory would not only continue to secure to us here these precious and priceless liberties but also for men and women the right freely to express themselves in speech and pen in many lands now enslaved and helpless.

We shall not fail. I need not speak of the heroism of our fighting men - the courage of our Army - the vigilance of the Navy - the skill and daring of our airmen and the unceasing labour of our industrial workers.

But I would speak today of what lies behind them - equally essential to Victory - a further line - both for attack and defence - and its name is Finance. Money is a real and powerful weapon which can enable us to bring about the defeat of the enemy and it is a weapon that most of us can use.

Continuous saving and lending to the State is not only the course of duty, it is the path of victory and security and safety.

There is a great gap between Wartime Expenditure and National Revenue.

It can be filled in two ways. One is the way of inflation. Now there is deliberate and ruthless inflation like that practised by the German Government in the Nineteen. Twenties. It leads to the depreciation of the currency, the extinguishment of investments, an astronomical rise in prices and general bankruptcy. I need hardly say no responsible Government in this country would ever embark upon such a course.

But there is also what might be called "natural" inflation the failure to finance the War by taxation and real savings, and
those of you who remember the last War will not have forgotten its
operation here.

It led to a chase between rising prices and inflated wages, to a scarcity of commidities, to queues and to profiteering.

It is owing to that experience and to the measures we have so far taken, that it has been possible so far to avoid these evils.

But let us always remember the danger is never absent if we even for a moment relax our efforts and stray from the strict but sure and safe course.

For the other way is taxation and saving. The people of this country must lend to the State to the point of sacrifice for taxation can only bear a part of our War expenditure.

We can be proud of what has already been achieved, but we can by no means be satisfied.

#### CHANCELLOR - 4.

Whilst there has been considerable improvement in savings in recent weeks, much more is required, and I have no doubt that the country is capable of increasing considerably its present efforts. Sir Robert Kindersley and his splendid team of workers will be only too ready to point the way as they have done with such success ever since the opening of the National Savings Campaign nearly a year ago.

We are facing a difficult and vital year in our history and no half measures will suffice.

For their part, the Govern ment can and must do everything possible to create conditions under which the maximum response to Government loans and to the appeal for National Savings can be fully attained.

It has been suggested in many quarters that subscriptions to our War Loan and our National Savings have been prejudiced because our people have been uncertain about their financial position in the event of air raid damage to their property, their furniture or their personal belongings.

That on this account many persons have felt constrained to keep larger cash resources which would otherwise be available for subscriptions to Government loans.

That is a perfectly natural reaction to the conditions under which we are living but the Government is now about to take certain important steps todeal with this difficult problem.

3 I hope shortly to introduce in Parliament a Bill providing for a scheme with retrospective effect to the beginning of the war under which full compensation will be paid for buildings destroyed or damaged by enemy action.

The Bill will also provide schemes to deal with plant and machinery and furniture and personal effects. The protection thus to be provided should go far to maintain confidence.

The scheme to deal with buildings will be compulsory and an essential feature of it will be adequate and substantial contributions from owners of property - aided in certain eventualities by the State - by way of a charge on property, coupled with arrangements for the collection of contributions on account.

Under the other scheme, we contemplate the setting up of machinery under which, for a reasonable charge, persons concerned will be able to insure against loss or damage by enemy action. The insurance of plant and machinery will, in general, be compulsory; that of furniture and personal effects will be voluntary.

These provisions will be of great value to the economy of the country and will also be helpful to our great Savings Movement by the removal of that uncertainty which, it is said, has acted as a brake upon their efforts.

The Dictators may have invented total war and certainly nobody would wish to pro them of that claim. It is for the people of this country to respond with their own version of total war not as the Nazi and the Fascist see it, but as a concrete expression of the uprising of a free people in which none is behindhand with his particular contribution.

We cannot all be members of the Fighting Forces nor even of the Civil Defence Services, but we can, and must, play our part by saving and lending to the State every penny that we can spare according to our individual circumstances.

It is in these ways and by redoubling our efforts that we can play a great part in bringing victory to our arms.

"Therefore let our proportion for these Wars be soon collected and all things thought upon that may with reasonable swiftness add more feathers to our wings."


#### Westminster's Warship
