THE KING AND QUEEN VIEW RAID DAMAGE IN LIVERPOOL

The King and Queen inspect damaged houses in Jersey Street where several people lost their lives. (Beetle District)

They also inspect Grenow place damage.

Liverpool Boundary - Brasenose Road.
The King and Queen walking round damaged Church and houses.

Gadsby Street - demolished houses and people involved.

Woman waving flag from ruins of building.

G.V. of wrecked houses, the Queen talks to people who have been buried in their house wreckage.

So Does the King. Mrs Brookes with children arms was buried for an hour before rescue.

The Woman on left lost 4 children and one now in hospital
Others in the picture lost three children.
