GREEKS ENTER ARGYROCASTRO MATERIAL

Scenes of close fighting at the moment are impossible to get.

The Greeks at this date, are advancing fast against a seemingly resistanceless Italian army, possible because they are hurrying back to attempt a
line of defence on the Skumbi river - about 30 miles North of Vallona.

It took us four days hard driving to get to Argyrocastro and then found that the Greeks had advanced further and multiple broken bridges made it impossible for us to get far enough, quick enough - and Head Quarters for the moment declared they were out of contact.

The scenes then were solely of fast advancing Greek troops and showing their difficulties of transport communications and weather. The Italian weakness seems unbelievable - at river crossings, while convoys congregated at the river - not an Italian plane was seen.

The Greek sappers meanwhile hurried the construction of bridges, using a pile driver (at the Molakas river crossing) which was Italian and had been left in their retreat only a few years from the blown up bridge :

The advance troops are living on bread only - some are in possession of half a blanket, some have none. These are the needs they are feeling most - blankets, boots, transport. The weather is acting as better air defence than even fighters ! They are putting up with fierce weather conditions cheerfully. In many things the Italians are helping by leaving behind good guns, ammunitions
