Message from Min of Supply.

Each bath dress takes 4 lbs. of clean wool, which weighs 4½ to 4½ lbs when it is greasy.

Of that wool 50% is Botany and 50% is cross-bred.

The Botany wool comes from Australia from Merino sheep, and cross-bred comes from the following countries in this order: -  
New Zealand, Britain, Australia,  
South America.

The average weight of a whole fleece from a sheep is roughly 6 lbs - so that one sheep would make one and half bath dresses.

The wool has first to be mixed by hand, then by machine.
