Following on the German occupation of Greece, ships of the Royal Hellenic Navy safely reach a Mediterranean Port.

In these pictures are seen shots of Greek destroyers at anchor, and scenes taken aboard the "AVEROFF", flagship of the Greek Havy.

These ships, during the time that Greece has been at War, have achieved notable successes sgainst Italian submarines.

The cruiser "AVEROFF" seen here is an Italian-built ship, built in 1910, and after the cowardly sinking by an Italian submarine before Greece had even entered the war, of the cruiser "HELLAS", is the only large ship which the Greeks possess, apart from several modern destroyers.

(Disregard second shot on Roll 1 which is of the French battleship "LORRAINE".)

An inspection aboard the "AVEROFF" is carried out by H.R.H. Prince Paul of Greece. Other shots show Greek sailors manning anti-aircraft guns and Greek sailors on Guard duty. Shot of Captain Viachapoulof, captain of the "AVEROFF", and a shot of Prince Paul with officers of the ship on the guarterdeck.
