"America delivers the goods" - and here is just a little of the motor transport alone which is now regularly arriving in huge quantities for use in the Middle Bast. The partly assembled vehicles arrive in wooden grates which are speedily unloaded from the ships on to lighters and taken to the guay where the unpacking and final assembly takes place in a very short time, and the increasing conveys that are now rumbling over the desert roads. Shots show:-The crates of M.T. being loaded from the ships on to lighters. The crates being brought to the guay - ditto being unpacked.
