The Duke's visit, coming so soon after the Executive's conferences at sea with Prime Minister Winston Churchill, generally was interpreted as another evidence of close Anglo-American cooperation, even though it was informal and not a State trip, as was the case when King George and Queen Elizabeth came to the United States shortly before the start of the war.

M. by automobile from New York, where the Duke landed at La Guardia Field after a flight from Canada, where he has been inspecting the Empire air training program for several weeks.
