3.	<u>ROLL THREE.</u> Opening few feet fogged due to necessity of clearing bent spool. Shots of R.A.F. and womens services. OOD close shots of tanks and guns. Run out on shots in Trafalgar square of posters etc on Nelsons column xx Flags on S. Africa house etc.
