GIANT TRANSPORT PLANE.

The 40 ton fifty seven passenger liner, the Constellation- which has made a new transcontinental non stop speed record. And here's the start, the mighty horsepower of motors roaring for the take-off from Burbank, California.

A useful type of transport plane for the Army in the war. The Constellation, when stripped for military use, will carry a hundred fully equipped soldiers. Going fast and up high. Most of the record breaking trip is made at altitudes of from fifteen thousand to 19 thousand feet.

Washington - and there she comes for the landing. The Constellation has crossed the continent in a few minutes less than 7 hours. Average speed- more than 352 and a half miles an hour. Shattering the coast to coast speed mark.

A headline flight, and the Secretary of Commerce, Jesse Jones congratulates the pilot - Howard Hughes of "round the world fame".
