1.	<u>Reel 1.</u> Mrs Winston Churchill, who opened the Fete, walked around the various side-shows accompanied by the Countess of Dudley and the Chairman. Also in some shots, the Earl of Dudley, with black eye shade.				
2.	Mrs Churchill looks at a portrait of "Winnie", which was raffled. Mrs Churchill buys a ticket for this car, also raffled. Mrs Churchill talks to the showman who set up his merry go rounds, etc in spite of their being seriously damaged by fire whilst en route to the fete.				
3.	Mrs Churchill and party walking past the largest poster in the world, over three hundred feet long. Mrs Churchill inspects detachments of Civil Defence men. General view of the opening ceremony with Hinley Hall, the seat of the Earl and Countess of Dudley, in background. Various angles on opening ceremony with Mrs Churchill speaking.				
4.	Wounded soldiers from Normandy many of whom are now in Hinley Hall, listening to Mrs Churchill speech.				
5.	<u>Reel 2.</u> Paratroops jumping from transport planes flying over Hinley Hall during the fete. Henry Cotton, partnered by Dr Tweddell, demonstrating chip shots, watched by wounded 'Tomnies'. Another attraction. the mixed dog show.				
6.	<u>Reel 3.</u> The Horse Gymkhana attracted thousands of the visitors to Hinley Park. Traedsnems vehicles on show in the ring. The Albrighton Woodland Hounds parading in the ring.				
7.	Competitors in the open jumping studying the jumps before competing. Amongst these competitors was the Countess of Dudley riding her white horse, "Snow Queen". (I waited to do her taking the water jump but her horse refused early in the round and she retired.)				
8.	Mrs Douglas Little, (DOROTHY ROUND), dark hair, played an exhibition tennis match against Miss Freda James. They are seen walking on to court. Dorothy Round in play.
