Description :

This is a sequence on a prisoner roundup. A captured German Captain led a small group of American volunteers in an attempt to make his men give up, after calling them through the streets of a small village near the french border in Belgium. It was a daring attempt but the results were quite satisfactory. Although the official count is unknown at present, between 300 and 400 prisoners were taken. Taken with them was one Belgium girl whose position was not completely clear, but who seems to be attached to one German soldier.

The searching party was made up of members of the 3rd. Arm'd Div. H.Q. Co, and Div. Artillery.  
The first scenes of roll one were of American tanks burning just inside Belgium. The caption had been erroneously sent in with the previous days shipment.
