The ack-ack girls who shot down enemy invaders of London, England are now helping to bring the enemy down once more nearer to his own country, before he gets to London.

The girls belong to No. 9 site of 150 Heavy (M) Ack Ack Regt. They have been in action since December 15th 1944 and live under estive service conditions as the camp is not yet completed. Their chief argets are Buzz Bombs of which have been shot down. This is the first mixed ACk Ack Regt. that has been in action in a theatre of war. The girls are all volunteers.
