IND-FOURTEEN'S ARMY-TOWN THE LEFT FLARK OF THE TWENTIE

The Ledo road from North Burma, through Myitkyina to the old Burma Road, is complete. One of the biggest engineering triumphs of the Far East it was begun by General Joseph Stilwell and to-day Chinese troops who were in Vinegar Joe's command marchialong the highway against the Japanese. is Stilwell mm not there to see them, for after his outspoken criticism of the Chinese government Chiang Kai Shek asked for his re-eall. Chinese and Burmese labourers many kept in repair those southern sections of the great highway which the enemy shelled as he fell back.

Weeks before mand schedule the first convoy bound for Japanese China travelled the Ledo road. Ever since the invasion of closed the Burma Road transport planes have carried war goods into China. Now the land route re-opened of guns, tanks and heavy transport goods impossible to transport by air will once gain feed the chinese war machine.
