CU Air Commodore talks:-

"And now as you see the Public are being told the secrets of Fido. But I think the public should know that FIDO in this war has served over 10,000 air crew lads - moreover FIDO has made it possible to carry out operations in base weather which would have stopped all flying in the past. Example of that was when in the Ardennes offensive Rudder tried to break through. Bomber support was necessary, heavy support and the Pathfinders were required to mark.....but Pathfinders base weather was fog..thick fog. The Pathfinders were there however because FIDO made it possible for the Pathfinders to take off and land in spite of this thick fog. However it's been of tremendous value to crews returning from operations to know that they could get down at their bases regardless of the weather. [Bomber Command are extremely grateful to the Ministry of Petroleum War fare for having produced such a magnificent British invention ..the Pathfinders in particular. We have mastered target weather .. I'm ~~am~~ very grateful to you for having made it possible for them to master base weather.]
