Cap Dramont + St. Tropez were the two main points of landing on 15. Aug. 44. Admiral Cunningham was C.M.C.

British - American + French Navies.

H.M. Ajax - Record. River Plate - Invasion of Normandy.

Bombarding on D Day in the South of France - she was roughly in the same position as she laid off to-day.

In contrast to-day along the French Riviera where a year ago there were landings against the enemy, (Khaki and steel helmets a thing of the past) these same blokes went ashore in full tropical whites to enjoy themselves.

Cap. Dramont. A Memorial of Tank landing Craft with open doors and a Tank just landing, will be built on this site, will cost 20,000,000 lbs, and will take two years to build - FRANCE'S MEMORIAL TO THE ALLIES.
