September 17th, 1945.

Arrival of the accused Belsen War Criminals at the Court. Kramer is the last out of the first lorry. Scenes in the Court, the Judges enter the court. The 48 prisoners enter the Court led by Kramer, No. 1, each has a number hung round his neck.

Various long shots of the prisoners in the dock. Shots of the Court showing the President.

General views of the Court. In front of the prisoners are Counsel for the Defence. C/U No. 1 Kramer. C/U No. 9 Irma Grese.

Views of Court showing Counsel for the Prosecution & people. Scenes showing the Press of the World reporting the trials. Scenes outside the Court showing how little interest was taken by the German people, but plenty of small boys gathered.

The Court House was well guarded. German Police check all papers. Outside the Court C/U The "Daily Worker" were allowed a War Correspondent for the first time, Iver Montagu is seen making notes outside the Court.

18th September, 1945

The President of the Court is received by the Guard, he inspects same and then proceeds into the Court for the Trials.

On the second day many women (German) attended the trials and after their papers were looked at British A.T.S. police searched them before they were admitted to the Court.
