

WAR CRIMES EVIDENCE PILES UP

Close observers of the Nuremberg trial report that the demeanor of the prisoners appears to indicate that they believe there is still hope. The world doesn't share that opinion. Jodl, Keitel, Ribbentrop and co, if not the despondent Funk, probably misinterpret the fairness of the proceedings as indicating that the verdict will be in their favour. Day by day the five-hour sittings unfold a mass of evidence which would convict them twenty times over. Yet every item is thoroughly sifted, as <sup>trial</sup> if it were an ordinary/in Britain. Reporting the trial is a considerable achievement. In addition to accounts for newspaper consumption, verbatim records are taken down by mechanical shorthand code machines which print a strip as they go along. How the case against the prisoners is built up was explained by the American Judge Jackson.

The large chart explaining the system of Nazi government awakened the prisoners to the keenest interest in the proceedings they have yet shown. Each of the criminals seemed most anxious that his own importance under Hitler should be emphasized. They almost fell out of the dock in eagerness to see the official copies.
