Owing to the smallness of the meat ration whereby a family of three will receive, in the locky, about 3 lbs. of meat for their Christmas joint, the demand for birds is about four times pre-War.

It does not matter how many regustered customers a trader has for meat. Supplies are based on the number of birds purchased by him before the War.

I hope to receive about a quarter of the number of turkeys I used to purchase.

From this you will see that it will be impossible to supply more than one family out of sixteen who desire a bird. May you be a lucky one.
