COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

The first banana ship the 'Tilapa' arrived at Avonmouth carrying the first cargo of bananas since the War.

These are all green and will go to special warehouses for ripening, after which they will be available to all children under 18.

The stems of green ~~xxxg~~ bananas are removed from the holds by conveyer belt system and then stacked into special banana railway vans which are steam heated. This is so that the fruit will not be affected by any sudden changes of temperature.

Reel 1. Various angles on dockers loading a special banana train with stems from conveyer belt.

Reel 2. The Lord Mayor of Bristol is greeted by the Captain of the 'Tilapa' when he comes to officially greet the ship. He is presented with a bunch of ripe bananas but being over 18 he hands them to 12 year old Daphne Richards, the daughter of one of the officials.
