

BRITON WINS NOBEL PRIZE

In Stockholm Concert Hall was held the first Nobel Prize Festival ~~ann~~ since 1938.

Members of the Swedish Royal Family, headed by the 87-year-old King Gustav, graced the proceedings. The great Swedish chemist Nobel left his immense fortune to endow five annual prizes; one each for ^{workers in} chemistry, physics, medicine, literature and the promotion of world-peace.

The U.S. Charge' d'affaires received the physics prize on behalf of his absent countryman, Wolfgang Pauli. Gabriella Mistral, of Latin America, was awarded the literature prize.

Perhaps the most popular award was made to the three British scientists ^{Hewling, Chain & Florey} who discovered ~~and developed~~ Penicillin - an example of scientific research for the benefit of all mankind.
