Right in the middle of the heat wave Mitchem warmed matters up with a blaze of 25,000-tons of rubber. Tyres, wellington boots, gasmasks, goggles, all on a Ministry of Supply dump of salvaged rubber burst into flame without warning. A general-call brought three-hundred firemen of forty-five brigades from all parts of London. The local water supply at first provided a mere trickle, till hoses were relaid from the River Wandle a mile away.
