### INTERVIEW WITH MR. CALDWELL, AUSTRALIAN MINISTER EMMIGRATION.

# SV Mr. C. seated desk.

"Australia believes that the world's finest export always has been and always will be men and women of British stock. It is on British stock that the Australian Commonwealth was founded. Australia wants more and more population from Britain; we need about 20 million people in Australia if we are to hold our island continent for ourselves and our descendants."

"Australia believes and always will believe that the best export the people of Britain can send to our country are British men and women. Australia was founded on British stock and Australia needs more and more people from Britain if she is to survive in the future.
