A700/511 Lt.-Gen. Sir James S. Steele, Commander-in-Chief, British Troops, and High-Commissioner in Austria, before taking up his appointment of Adjutant-General to the Forces, was the guest of Marshal Tito, at Bled on September 8th. Sir James Steele was accompanied by Lady Steele and members of his staff, and the British Ambassador at Belgrade and Mrs. Peak were also present.

The meeting took place at Bled Villa, the magnificent country residence of Marshal Tito. The original building was destroyed by the Gestapo and opened again in July this year.
