Delhi Province which was the scene of communal disturbances is seriously affected by sudden floods. Property worth millions of rupees is under water and many have been rendered homeless. Delhi was not prepared for floods and the arrangements for rescuing people are not very satisfactory. Due to disturbances, there was dislocation of telephone and telegram services and the information about floods was received at such a time when the administration, which is already over worked on accounts of riots and disturbances, could not render much help. Quite a number of evacuees had to walk through water to reach some safe spot.

The present floods are going to result in a set back in the already scarce condition of food grain. Quite a large number of wheat growing plots were under water.
