ROLL ONE.

Marked with shot of one finger.

Few scenes of the Derwent Reservoir of the Derwent Valley Water Board. Shows the massive dam over which water normally pours with the water level almost at its base. Also odd general view up the reservoir and a pan down from normal water level to the actual water.

 Marked by a shot of two fingers.

Scenes of the Ladybower reservoir - immediately below the above reservoir. This valley was flooded just before the war submerging the village of Derwent. These scenes show the church tower standing clear of the water, this is usually almost submerged. Also shows other roofs just coming through the surface.

=====
 Marked by shot of three fingers.

Run out on a few shots of the bed of Woodhead reservoir belonging to Manchester Corporation. Shows the stream trickling through the bed of the empty reservoir and the hard caked mud.

ROLL TWO.

A couple of g.v.s of the reservoir.

Several shots of men digging in bed to divert stream along reservoir bed to outlet.

Shooting had to be suspended due to the poor weather conditions which were rapidly deteriorating still further making g.v.s absolutely impossible. It is hoped to get these tomorrow when the location will be revisited to obtain material of bulldozers etc working which should be working then. (they were just preparing today and not actually in position).
