EDINBURGH AT BUTLIN'S REUNION

"Mr. Butlin, Ladies and Gentlemen: Thank you very much indeed for your kind welcome this evening, and thank you all for this wonderful contribution to the Playing Fields of this country.

As you heard, this scheme was started 32 years ago, and it was decided then (lens change) that the money raised would be spent in the town in which most of the campers had come from. As a result of this other fields or pavilions have been started or planmed over an enormous number of places - Coventry, Liverpool, Halifax, Oldham, Bolton, Carlisle, and I think tomorrow Wigan will be added to the list (laughter).
