MRS% CHURCHILL LAUNCHES CARRIER

The Navy's 18-thousand-ton Aircraft Carrier Hermes
was named by Mrs. Churchill at Vickers Armstrongs Shipyard,
Barrew-in-Furness. A steel stand collapsed before the
ceremony, without serious harm.

Hermes will have a steam catapault for launching heavy aircraft and an angled flight-deck.

In war the new carrier (740-feet long)
would carry 1400 men. Speed 30 knots. A
powerfull addition to the navy's carrier fleet.
