Reel I.

Mau Mau massacre at Lari location, Uplands.

Picture shows recently constructed Pelice Station and compounds at Uplands. The Kikuyu in the Pelice compound are men that were arrested in the Lari location after the massacre for purpose of screening. The shot of the men segregated into the inner barbed wire compound show which are known to have been implicated, and are awaiting trial. Contrary to press reports, the Lari location is NOT a village - but a scattering of homesteads maintain over a large area, an example of which is shown here of such a homestead in the location, which is now deserted.

We then move on Headman Pacle's home - picture shows butchered bodies by the burned huts as he found them on his return from Homeguard patrol.

Reel II.

As the massacre was obviously directed against LOYAL Kikuyus, the proof of this is seen in our next scene, where two adjacent "shambas" (homes) side by side - the one was completely burned down and occupants massacred, while the other must have been occupied by Mau Mau sympathisers, and was untouched.

We then move over to Chief Luka's homestead, some fameralized two miles further. As A very loyal Chief ever since the start of the Emergency, several attacks have already been made on his life. Scene kinner again shows the ruthlessness with which the Mau Mau terrorists acted, and the devastation they left. The two vehicles in the middle of the compound although they (Mau Mau) traid to fire them, did not burn, but broken windscreens, etc. can be seen. As is common in the tropics, directly there is a sign of blood vultures appear. Vultures can be seen in this shot.

Reel III.

Troops

Hastings Aircraft lands at Nairobi bringing the first party of the Buffs. Various scenes on the aerodrome.

Reel IIII.

Ground personnel of the R.A.F. immediately surround Hastings aircraft, and the plane is prepared for its return journey.

EMBUS

Buff Personnel are fallen in and marched off to waiting vehicles, and Buffs.
