Subject: First exchange of wounded P.O.Ws.
Place: Panmunjom.
Cameraman: Gene Zenier and Kim Wee.

- Roll 1: (Munsan) Train arriving at Munsan at 5a.m. which is loading wounded N. Korean Communists. Then P.O.Ws being unloaded from train at TASP to ambulance for ride to Panmunjom.
- Roll 2. By side of train, many ambulances are waiting. N. Korean P.O.Ws unloading from train and getting on those ambulances.

(Above two rolls were shot in rain).
- Roll 3. First 40' shot of Communist P.O.Ws transferred to ambulance. Train of ambulances carrying N. Korean P.O.Ws to Panmunjom passing Freedom Bridge.
- Roll 4. Gen. Clark, U.N. Commander in Chief, Gen. Weyland, Chief of Far East Air Force, Lt. Gen. Taylor, Commander of Eight Army, Lt-Gen. Harrison, Chief U.N. delegation to Armistice Talk, and Gen. Barcus, Commander of 5th Air Force are getting off the train at TASP and watching the N. Korean P.O.Ws being transferred to ambulance.
- Roll 5. At Freedom village, first U.N. P.O.Ws are carried back on 'copter and 5 top ranking officers are entering into tent where the U.N. P.O.Ws are evacuated for the first treatment. Pfc. Robert C. Stell happened to be the first returned prisoner being interviewed.
- Roll 6. Ambulances from Panmunjom arriving at Freedom Village loading many U.N. P.O.Ws. They are greeted by Gen. Clark and Gen. Taylor.
- Roll 7. Ali Biler, Robert C. Stell and John P. Porter are carried on stretchers to helicopter. Kirohausen (left) and Donald Legay are being interviewed by press. Also shows Cpl. Kenyon Wagner of Detroit, Mich, and another Greek Soldier.

General Mark Clark, Commander of U.S. and U.N. forces in Far East, arrives in Korea to witness the return of the first allied sick and wounded prisoners released by the Communists under the P.O.W. exchange agreement signed recently.

Clark headed a large array of top ranking officers who gathered at this advance U.N. truce camp to see the boys come back.

It was the largest gathering of top ranking commanders in one place since the visit of President Eisenhower last December.

- Roll 1: C.U. sign TASP. C.U. sign Ambulance car. M.C.U. North Korean soldiers. M.C.U. the Red Cross sign and M.P. M.L.S. Ambulance stops near side of train. M.C.U. Ambulance and guards. M.C.U. North Korean P.O.W. comes down from train.
- Roll 2: F.S. North Korean P.O.Ws come down from train and ride truck. F.S. same. F.S. Camera pans from one-legged P.O.W. to another POW getting into vehicle. M.L.S. News reporters. M.G.U. POWs coming down from train. C.U. POW with false leg.
- Roll 3: Maj-Gen. Thomas Herren, Commanding General KCOMZ, left. Brig-Gen. Lionel McGarr, C.G. POW Comd. Long line of ambulance crossing the Imjim River...M.L.S. F.S. representatives of various countries on hand to take over their POWs released from the Communists. General Clark and Taylor welcome the representatives of the various U.N. countries. F.S. the POW to be released is flown by helicopter.
- Roll 4: General Clark, Taylor Warren and Harrison walk into processing tent to greet the released prisoners. Gen. Clark and his party come out of tent. C.U. released U.N. prisoner No. 1 is carried away on stretcher. The name is Pfc. Robert C. Steer. F.S. entering the ambulance tent. M.L.S. Gen. Clark and Taylor greet the released prisoners who come out of the ambulance tent. F.S. released U.N. prisoners shake hands with Gen. Clark & Taylor. Same.
- Roll 5: R.S. released U.N. POWs hug their buddies. C.U. Released P.O.Ws. Same. Arch welcoming the released U.N. prisoners. F.S. C.U. released British P.O.W. O'Donnell. Released British P.O.W. Hunt.

- Roll 1: First 40' shot of U.N. ambulances arriving at Panmunjom loading wounded North Korean and Chinese Red prisoners. Rest of roll covers the line-up of ambulances with U.N. POWs as they arrive Panmunjom. First U.N. POW shown here is Pte. Carl Kirchausen from New York.
- Roll 2: Entirely covers first U.N. POWs as they arrive at Panmunjom. First POW to be embraced is a Turk soldier who is greeted by Turkish officer. Second POW greeted is a Greek.
- Roll 3: All roll covers first U.N. litter cases to arrive.
- Roll 4: 1. Covers litter cases as they are speedily evacuated from Panmunjom by helicopters.
2. Shows ambulance convoy with N. Korean POWs heading towards Panmunjom.
3. Pte. Kenyon Wagner from Detroit, Mich. as he leaves tent at Freedom Village. In next cut, Wagner is interviewed by U.N. Correspondents.
