I enclose information about our Victor grescent-wing bomber-This will help with the commentary on the air-to-air film you are receiving from the Shell Film Unit.

The film was taken from an Avre Lencaster war-vintage bomber and thus it was necessary for the Victor pilet, although flying on very lew power, to apply his live-brukes frequently to avoid everaheeting the photographic aircraft. The dive brakes are seen in some of the shots; they move outwards from the fuscings beneath the tailplane, increasing drag and alowing the bomber down.
