Austrian Scales 26,660-foot ciant.

Gilgit, July 6th: The 26,660-foot Manga Parbat has been conquered

by the Austro-Gorman expedition.
According to information reaching here today the gient Himeleyan
peak which had hitherto replused eight attempts at its conquest was
scaled on July 4th. at 10 in the morning by a veteran Austrian climber. Resching the top in clear blue sky Hermann Buhl planted the flags

of Takistan and Federal Sopublic of Germany on the summit and there stood there for a few minutes.

lying on the outer fringes of the Himalayas kage Manga Farbat has been a challenge to the mountaineers all over the world, since the later

half of the 19th. century.

Hight major attempts had been previously made to break the pride of the mountain out they all fell through, two of them in the years of 1934 and 1937 ended in complete disaster of expeditions.

The mighty and clorious though inhospitable mountain has at last obliged and bowed down to the persistent efforts of the man to conquer the nature.

Its refulgent silver crest still shines gracefully, nearly five miles high in the blue sky, but is short of such of the legend which this name has come to signify.

The scornful lines on its age worm heavy forehead look deeper today.

but the sting in their seern is gone and perished for ever.

A man has at last brought its proud susmit to his feet. Wringing its erown of fame, he decorated his own head with it. A pride is broken and a new one created. A legend is made at the cost of an old one.
