THEN, FROM THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE LEN HUTTON ADDRESSED THE SILENT MULTITUDE.

"I FEEL A LITTLE BIT SORRY FOR MY FRIEND LINDSAY HASSETT WHO HAS HAD RATHER A HARD TIME OF IT THIS SEASON - AND WHAT A WONDERFUL OPPOSING CAPTAIN TO PLAY AGAINST. MAY AUSTRALIA CONTINUE TO PRODUCE CRICKETERS OF HIS CALIBRE, WHO HAVE DONE SO MUCH FOR THE GAME. THANK YOU ALL."

LINDSAY HASSETT, SOUNDING FAR MORE JUBILANT THAN HE MUST HAVE FELT CAME TO THE MICROPHONE. HE SAID, "I WOULD JUST LIKE TO OFFER MY CONGRATULATIONS TO LEN AND THE ENGLISH TEAM. THEY HAVE EARNED THIS VICTORY FROM THE VERY FIRST BALL - OF THE SECOND TO LAST OVER ANYWAY," HE SAID AMID A ROAR OF LAUGHTER FROM THE EAGER CROWD.

"LEN WAS QUITE RIGHT WHEN HE SPOKE OF OUR DIFFICULTIES," CONTINUED THE AUSTRALIAN CAPTAIN, "ESPECIALLY AS I HAVE BEEN SUFFERING FROM AN INJURED RIGHT FOREARM." - MORE LAUGHTER.

LINDSAY HASSETT PAID TRIBUTE TO THE OVAL CROWD FOR THEIR SPORTING BEHAVIOUR THROUGHOUT THE MATCH. "I FEEL RATHER PROUD OF THE WAY THE AUSTRALIAN BOYS PLAYED AND I THINK THAT YOU ALSO ENJOYED THE WAY WE PLAYED.

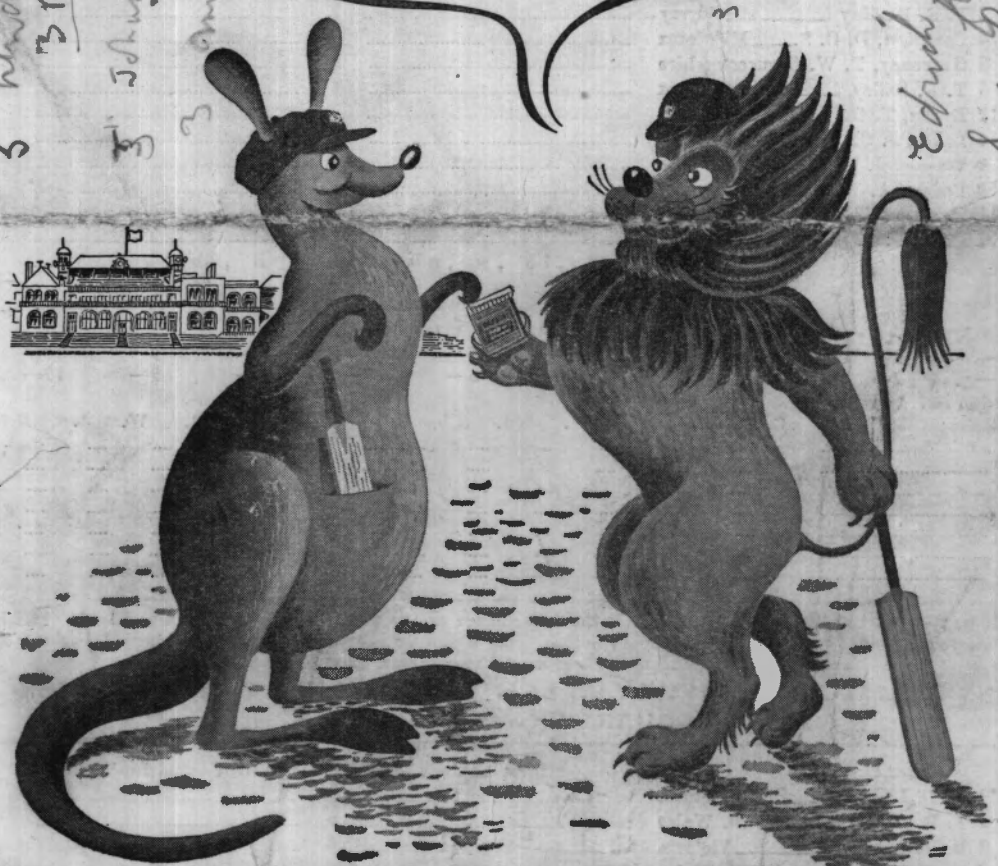
