For the survivors of Cephalonia, Largest of the Ionian
Islands, the future seems bleak. After the appalling
calamity and the relief at having escaped, the
hundred-thousand homeless face the problem where and how
to live. And with much cooler weather only a few weeks
away it's hard to see how they can be accommodated.

Now come pictures, delayed during the first days of chaos,
of Earl Mountbatten visiting Argostoli, capital of
and the neighbouring island of Zante
Cephalonia/a few hours after the earthquake.

The Admiral promptly organized relief measures and spontaneously other mavies in the Mediterranean sent their aid.

aid. Only on the international scale can adequate help be

provided. These delayed films include amazing pictures, taken only
