Western Germany has given an absolute majority to Federal German Chancellor Adenauer. His opponents denounced him as a new Hitler but his countrymen, and women, had more sense. His genial friend President Heuss radiated confidence as usual, believing, like most Western Germans, that it would be fatal to German interests to break with the Western nations. Herr Ollenhauer, Social Democrat Leader and Adenauer's chief opponent, was decisively beaten. The Chancellor himself recorded his vote. He seemed to have no doubt which way the election would go.
