COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

The R.A.F. Mountain Rescue teams of the 19th group take part every week end in mock rescue exercises -- In this exercise two teams "Valley" and St; Athan were the participants. These two teams cover most of the mountain area in this part of the country and can be called out in any emergency either civil or R.A.F.

The teams consist of five permanent members and roughly ~~twenty~~ twenty volunteers . The volunteers are from all ranks, trades and areas.

The exercise comprises of two volunteers climbing the mountain and loosing themselves as if they had come down in an aircraft. The others then go out to find them in teams of five or six in each party. When they are found they are given first aid and in the case of a wounded man brought down by stretcher, as in this case.

All shots taken are about this above exercise, and of course self explanatory.

Some of the stuff may be fogged as I jammed twice. Some of it may be N.B.G. as conditions were to say the least impossible. Men are trained extensively to climb in these areas and even so are still in trouble at times-- I'm a city boy.
