Three short ends used with H.P.S. inside the caravan ... Shots show the dump, where Jim Ruff has done his watching for the past few years, his job being to look after machines such as bull dozers etc and scrap metal rustlers and of course looking out for fires etc .

Shots inside the caravan show a couple of his mates looking in for a cup of tea, Jim looking out ... sea gulls (often his only companions) for hours at a stretch....during the last few years he has done over 100 hours per week, being on duty, every night of the week, cycling from Brentford to the Isleworth, six miles night & morning ... Jim is one armed, he lost his arm in a mill accident .. shots of his wife Nellie and the dog Boxet ..

This couple are veryhonest to God sort of people and until now, quite poor, his money being somewhere about 27 per week..

To get the necessary permission, to take shots on this dump etc. I had to interview about four officials of the Ilesworth council, finishing with the town clerk, quite pleasent but apprehensive about what we might say in the commentry.

A couple of shots of him leaving and arriving, his wife

has seen him off, like this for years ...
