1. General view of the 'Punch' ideal schoolroom stand on which cartoons by well known comic artists are working in lifesize. Various angles & close ups which can be followed by the accompanying pictures
2. General view outside the hall with schoolboys lined up to get in
3. Closer sign
4. Closer kids & some buying gum
5. Close shots of RAF men at controls of Hunters
- 5.a. Gen. view of the stand by the RAF on which there are models of the Hunters flying - they are driven by compressed air but behave just like jets
6. Closer shots of kids watching the models & of models
7. The Army has its show too--The Royal Artillery have gun and kids try their hand out at controls
- 7a. A demonstration of glass blowing attracts the kids
8. General view of the 'flying saucer' that has crash landed in the hall -- in the gondola at the mike is Sir Harry Brittain who is President of the Show.
9. In the control room of the 'saucer' -- Sir Harry & Mr. Boyd Carpenter (Minister of Transport ?) try out the controls, with closer shots of controls
10. Sir Harry Brittain (who is 81 years of age) is still the schoolboy at heart and he tries a 'lolly' semi & else ups
11. Kids try out the controls in the control room of the 'saucer'
12. A model car race - cars remotely controlled with a steering wheel in the hand. Several angles with close ups of steering wheel in hand panning to car.
