Scen by Scen:

The giant jumping hill of KULM in Styria-Austria was for the second time the site of a "Skifliegen" (ski-flying) In this competition length of each jump is counted regardless of the style except when the jumper touches the ground while landing with his hands the jump does not count. Competitors from 8 Nations were present highest rated the Finns and the third in the jumping contest in Cortina Harry Glass. The weather was very poor it was snowing and very windy many spills occurred.

Our rough cut shows:

Long shots of the site - jumpers making ready - jumps and spills - next to last spill Sepp Klessl (Westgermany) was carried off the ground with minor wounds - last spill the favorite Harry GLASS (East-Germany) who forfeited his chances close up of Harry Glass - Next jumper Björstad (Norway) longest jump 115 Meters scored Third - Next HEINONEN (Finland) longest jump 119 Meters scored Second - Next Werner LESSER (East-Germany) longest jump 122 Meters the record and winner of the contest. This was also the longest jump ever done from this hill.

As said, the remarkable success of the East-Germans was obtained because the jumpers are training all year long, in summertime on plastic snow:
