DAG HAMMARSKJOLD SEES FOR HIMSELF

The United Nations Secretary General reached Lydda Airport, Israel. General Burns, 2 the Canadian who is United Nations Chief Truce Supervisor, met Mr. Hammarskjold. They lunched together before the Secretary General flew to Cairo. Evidence of ambushes and sabotage by Egyptian irregulars the tells its own story. Four citizens of Israel were killed and 15 wounded. Intensifying the already bad feeling between Israel and Egypt the latest incidents might have led to war. And where that would stop no man could tell. Israelis whose houses are damaged, to say nothing of those whose relatives are among the killed or wounded, are at the moment very angry people . Egypt meanwhile charges that Israeli aircraft have flown over Egyptian territory. In an Israeli prison camp Egyptian prisoners are being questioned, to see what they know about the latest raids. They look like very humble pawns in the game.
