## GRAND PRIX DE MONACO :

The British driver Stirling Moss, on a Masersti, won the 14th. Grand Prix de Monaco. The race was watched by more than 50,000 spectators.

Stirling Moss got off to a flying start and soon took the leadership of the competitors which he retained till the end. By so doing, he was spared the difficulties of many of his competitors who drove far too close to one another. The Monaco circuit which winds its way round and round does not allow for that kind of driving. As a result many of the hardy drivers had to give up and by the time the 15th. lap was being run only 10 remained. This only enhanced the tense interest in the rece the highlight of which was the close chase between Fangio and Moss. The Argentine driver (Fangie) ended the race by reaching the final post 7 seconds after Moss although he had been until then 51 seconds behind him on the circuit.

At the close of the race, Jean Behra, who ended third, retained his title of world champion with Fangio and Moss as runners-up.
