

## TERRORIST ROUND UP INTENSIFIED

A ten-day comb out of the Troodos Mountain area was rewarded by the capture of seven Eoka terrorists, two of them with a price of £5,000 on their heads. It was all part of the campaign inspired by Sir John Harding to destroy completely the terrorist organisation., if possible by arrest. Military intelligence <sup>now</sup> estimates them at no more than ~~some~~ 150. This time their leader, General George Grivas, called Uncle George by the troops, very narrowly escaped capture.
