rewarded by the capture of seven Eoka terrorists, two of them with a price of £5,000 on their heads. It was all part of the campaign inspired by Sir John Harding to destroy completely the terrorist organisation., if possible by arrest. Military intellegence estimates them at no more than hamma 150. This time their leader, General George Grivas, called Uncle George by the troops, very narrowly escaped capture. Mortar fire was directed against forest area in which the rebels were thought to be hiding. Helicopter observation directed the fire.
