G.V. shot strikers milling around No. 15. Gate of the Morris Cowley Works.

Semi C.U. strikers lining up to go into Works' Labour Bureau Building to collect their holiday pay. (Their fortnight's holiday starts as from tonight).

Two C.U.'s types looking at their pay packets.

Two G.V.'s Meeting which was called by Union Officials as a "report back" meeting after they had had discussions with Birmingham Union Officials. This Meeting took place in Hockmore Street, Cowley.

C.U. shot of Mr. A. Bradley addressing meeting. He is the Branch Sec. of the Transport & General Workers' Union, Morris Mobors Branch.

Various C.U. cut-in shots of strikers listening to the address, hand-clapping, etc.

C.U. Mr. Jack Longworth addressing the meeting. He is the Divisional Organiser of the Amalgamated Engineering Union.

Crowd cut-in shot.

(Note: The main points expressed in this "report back" meeting were:"Solidarity will win".
"They want prior consultations before the mass sackings".

After the Meeting it was decided that the strikers should line the pavements just below No.3. Gate of the Morris Cowley Works and stand in "silent protest" as the employees who are still at work left the factory.

G.V.'s of these employees (who are still working) leaving the factory, mostly on cycles, riding home past the strikers lined up on pavements.

Various types holding up Union Cards as the non-strikers ride past. Crowd shot. (There were no scrimmages today).
