

At the OTAN Athletic championships in Berlin, there was a threefold sensation. On the first day, the coloured US-soldier Willie Williams ran 100 metres in 10,1 seconds. On the same field, Jesse Owens had run his world's record with 10,1 in 1936, a speed, which was only reached by 8 athletes in the meantime.

On the second day, also a coloured American - Ira Murchison - ran the same speed.

X On the last day (not covered) the both new world's record athletes met. Williams happened to reach again 10,1 seconds, but Murchison now had only a speed of 10,2 seconds.
