- Box 1. Sound camera (shot by Pullen)
1. The Centenarian Special with 80 year old engine pulls out from Purley station
- Box 2. Roll 1.
1. Close of poster announcing the celebrations
 2. Banner outside Caterham station
 3. Name of station
 4. Shots of the band in full blast to welcome the 'Centenarian'
 5. The train steams into Caterham station -- several shots with people alighting
- Roll 2
6. The Chairman of Caterham District Council -Councillor Howes- makes address of welcome
 7. Sundry shots of the train and the Chairman with the driver, fireman and guard, all dressed for the part
 8. Up by the engine the Chairman meets the driver etc.
- Roll 3
- (Here are some shots to cut-in between the two stations -I could not do them on the run to Caterham so had to be content on the return journey. Unfortunately, however, the engine could not be turned round and so was facing the wrong way to include in any of the shots)
9. The guard gets aboard and takes his place on the look-out seat.
 10. Various shots en route looking along the train with sightseers giving the train a welcome (These will do to fit in on the journey)
