More than a hundred elephants were in the final procession of the Festival of Peharera. From all over Ceylon people pour into Kandy to take part in the 14-day celebrations.

The casket containing the sacred tooth of Biddha is borne from the temple through the streets along a three-mile route. The Festival orignated over 2,000 years ago to mark Geylon's victory over invaders from Southern India; but for the past 300 years it has been a religious observance only.

The American Navy's Super Constellation wasn't carrying a Flying Saucer; that part of it was a radome, a new word for a new idea. It contained a lot of experimental radar equipment pastprants, enabling the engineers to see further, on the screen, than ever before. More than that the experts in the know won't say.
