National Exhibition of Children's Art 1956.

May I please draw your attention to the showing of the above exhibition at the Royal Institute Galleries, 195, Piccadilly, London, W.1. This exhibition will be open to the public from Wednesday, 5th September to Saturday, 29th September inclusive, from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. except Sundays.

It is the ninth exhibition that we have organised, and it will consist of 413 paintings and pottery models, by children aged between five to sixteen. Last years exhibition has just arrived in the U.S.S.R. for a tour lasting one year.

The press preview of this years exhibition will be from 10.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. on Tuesday, 4th September, and the private view will be held from 2.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. on the same day.

The craft work and paintings in this exhibition have been selected from an initial entry of over 35,000.


