Returning from the last Mediterranean cruise of the season the liner Lancastria went ashore in a gale near Wallasey. Four hundred and fiftyfour passengers and a crew of three hundred and fifty were on board at the time. As the tide went out the Lancastria was left high and dry, but eight hours later tugs were able to pull her into fleep water.
